2022 Generation Church Holy Land Tour

PROGRAM ITINERARY | February 7-17, 2022

Day 1 – Monday, February 7

Depart from the U.S.

Day 2 – Tuesday, February 8

Arrive in Israel. Overnight in Netanya (north of Tel Aviv on the Mediterranean coastline).

Day 3 – Wednesday, February 9

Caesarea, Mount Carmel, and Arbel Synagogue. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4 – Thursday, February 10

Nazareth, Mt. Precipice, Kefar Kedem (1st century breadmaking and lunch), and Magdala. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5 – Friday, February 11

Morning boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, Ancient Boat, Almagor (overlook of the lake in which 95% of the ministry of Jesus took place), Mt. of Beatitudes, Chorazim, Capernaum, and Jordan River Baptisms. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 6 – Saturday, February 12

Dan, Banias (Caesarea Philippi), Har Bental (Syria overlook). Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 7 – Sunday, February 13

Bethlehem (Church and Shepherd's Field), and Israel Museum. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 – Monday, February 14

Masada, Qumran, Ein Gedi, Dead Sea (with an option to swim), and Wadi Qilt (Jericho Road overlook). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9 – Tuesday, February 15

Temple Mount, Western Wall, David Center (Southern Wall Excavations), and free time in the Old City. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 10 – Wednesday, February 16

Mount of Olives, Dominus Fleuit, Garden of Gethsemane, Jaffa Gate, Tower of David Museum (overlook), Wohl Museum (high priestly mansions), Cardo, Gennath Gate, Church of the Holy Sepulchre, and communion at a first-century tomb. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 11 – Thursday, February 17

Depart from Israel. Arrive back in the U.S.
