PROGRAM ITINERARY | April 23-May 4, 2022

Day 1 – Saturday, April 23

Depart from the U.S.

Day 2 – Sunday, April 24

Arrive in Israel. Overnight in Beersheva.

Day 3 – Monday, April 25

Beersheva, Ein Avdat (Wilderness wonderings), Kfar Hanokdim (Bedouin Hospitality, Camel Rides, and Dinner). Overnight in Beersheva.

Day 4 – Tuesday, April 26

Elah Valley (David and Goliath), Caesarea (Jews and Gentiles, Cornelius, Paul), and Mount Carmel (Elijah) Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5 – Wednesday, April 27

Dan Nature Reserve, Caesarea Philippi, and Har Bental (Syrian/Damascus Road Overlook). Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 6 – Thursday, April 28

Nazareth (The family of Jesus), Mount Precipice, Kfar Kedem (1 century village and lunch), and Magdala (ancient Magdala). Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 7 – Friday, April 29

Mount of Beatitudes, Chorazin, Capernaum, Nof Ginnosar (ancient first-century boat), boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, and Jordan River Baptism's. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 8 – Saturday, April 30

Bethlehem (Shepherd's Field and Church), Israel Museum (Second Temple First Century outdoor Model and Shrine of the Book – the Dead Sea Scrolls), and free time in the Old City. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9 – Sunday, May 1

Masada Ein Gedi, Qumran – Cave 4 only and Lunch, and Dead Sea (with an option to swim). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 10 – Monday, May 2

Wadi Qilt (Jericho Road overlook and the story of the Good Samaritan – “who is my neighbor?”), Mount of Olives, Dominus Flevit (an ancient church on the way down the Mt. of Olives where the weeping of Jesus over Jerusalem is commemorated), Garden of Gethsemane, Lunch and Free-Time (Jewish Quarter), Southern Steps of the Temple, and the Western Wall. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 11 – Tuesday, May 3

Jaffa Gate (entrance to the Old City), Herod's Palace (Citadel – the place where Jesus was presented to Herod), Ancient Via Dolorosa/Cardo (the authentic way of the cross), Wohl Museum (high priestly mansions – and the example of why Jesus was killed – money and power), Jewish Quarter Lunch, Church of the Holy Sepulchre (the likely location of the death and resurrection of Jesus), and Communion at a first century rolling stone tomb. Farewell dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 12 – Wednesday, May 4

Morning departure for Ben Gurion airport. Arrive back to U.S.A.
