PROGRAM ITINERARY | February 28-March 12, 2023

Day 1 – Tuesday, February 28

Depart from the U.S.

Day 2 – Wednesday, March 1

Arrive in Israel. Overnight in Beersheva.

Day 3 – Thursday, March 2

Beersheva (Abraham), En Avdat (Moses), and Elah Valley. Overnight in Netanya.

Day 4 – Friday, March 3

Mount Carmel, Nazareth, Mt. Precipice, and Arbel Cliff. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5 – Saturday, March 4

Almagor, Chorazin, Capernaum, Magdala, Nof Ginnosar (time permitting), and nighttime boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 6 – Sunday, March 5

Yad Vashem, Israel Museum (Second Temple Model and Shrine of the Book), and Bethlehem (Sheppard's Field only). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 7 – Monday, March 6

Masada, Qumran, Ein Gedi, and Dead Sea (with an option to swim). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 – Tuesday, March 7

Temple Mount, City of David, Jaffa Gate, Tower of David (overlook), Ancient Via Dolorosa, Cardo, Wohl Museum, and Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Overnight in Jerusalem

Day 9 – Wednesday, March 8

Mount of Olives, Dominus Flevit, Garden of Gethsemane, Western Wall, and Davidson Center - Southern Temple Steps (communion). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 10 – Thursday, March 9

Caesarea. Late Afternoon flight to Athens. Overnight in Athens.

Day 11 – Friday, March 10

Acropolis, Mars Hill, Parthenon, and Agora. Free time in Athens with optional visit to the Acropolis Museum. Overnight in Athens.

Day 12 – Saturday, March 11

Corinth Canal, Ancient Corinth (Museum, Temple of Apollo, Bema and Agora), and Cenchrea (5th century Christian Basilica). Overnight in Athens.

Day 13 – Sunday, March 12

Transfer to Athens airport for return flight to U.S.
