PROGRAM ITINERARY | January 6-15, 2023

Day 1 – Friday, January 6

Depart from the U.S.

Day 2 – Saturday, January 7

Arrive in Israel. Overnight in Netanya (north of Tel Aviv on the Mediterranean coastline).

Day 3 – Sunday, January 8

Caesarea, Mount Carmel, and Nazareth. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4 – Monday, January 9

Har Bental (Syria overlook), Banias (Caesarea Philippi), and Dan. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5 – Tuesday, January 10

Jordan River baptism, Almogor (overlook of ministry of Jesus), Chorazin, Capernaum, Magdala, Nof Ginnosar (ancient boat), and a nighttime boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 6 – Wednesday, January 11

Masada, Qumran, Ein Gedi, Dead Sea (with an option to float). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 7 – Thursday, January 12

Israel Museum, Bethlehem. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 – Friday, January 13

Western Wall, City of David, and Davidson Center (Southern Wall Excavations), Wohl Museum (high priestly mansions), and free time in the Old City. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9 – Saturday, January 14

Wadi Qilt (Jericho Road overlook), Mount of Olives, Dominus Flevit, Garden of Gethsemane, Jaffa Gate, Tower of David Museum, Cardo, Gennath Gate, Church of the Holy Sepulchre, and communion at a first-century tomb. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 10 – Sunday, January 15

Depart from Israel. Arrive back in the U.S.
