Day 1 – Tuesday, November 4

Depart from the U.S.

Day 2 – Wednesday, November 5

Arrive in Israel. Overnight in Netanya.

Day 3 – Thursday, November 6

Caesarea, Mount Carmel, and Nazareth. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4 – Friday, November 7

Mt of Beatitudes, Capernaum, Chorazin, Magdala, and Jordan River Baptisms. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5 – Saturday, November 8

Meggiddo, Beth Shean, Har Barkan, Ein Harod, Tel Jezreel, and boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 6 – Sunday, November 9

Masada, Qumran, Ein Gedi, and Dead Sea (with an option to float). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 7 – Monday, November 10

Elah Valley (Aseka), Bethlehem (Church of the Nativity and Shepherd's Field), and Israel Museum (Model and Dead Sea Scrolls). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 – Tuesday, November 11

Temple Mount, Western Wall Tunnels, City of David, and Davidson Center (Southern Wall Excavations), and Western Wall Prayer. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9 – Wednesday, November 12

Wadi Qilt (Jericho Road overlook). Mount of Olives, Dominus Flevit, Garden of Gethsemane, Jaffa Gate, Tower of David Overlook, Cardo, Gennath Gate, Whol Museum, Church of the Holy Sepulchre, and communion at a first-century tomb. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 10 – Thursday, November 13

Return to the USA for non-extension participants.

Extension:

Arad, Beersheva, En Avdat, Boarder Crossing into Jordan. Overnight in Wadi Rum.

Day 11 – Friday, November 14

Petra. Overnight in Petra.

Day 12 – Saturday, November 15

Madaba, Mt. Nebo on the drive to Amman. Overnight in Amman.

Day 13 – Sunday, November 16

Return to the USA via Amman.
