PROGRAM ITINERARY | July 6-17, 2026

Day 1 – Monday, July 6

Depart from the U.S.

Day 2 – Tuesday, July 7

Arrive in Israel. Overnight in the South.

Day 3 – Wednesday, July 8

Beersheva, En Avdat, and Elah Valley. Overnight in Netanya.

Day 4 – Thursday, July 9

Caesarea, Mount Carmel, and Nazareth. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5 – Friday, July 10

Dan Nature Reserve, Caesarea Phillipi, Har Bental (Syrian Overlook), and boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 6 – Saturday, July 11

Mt. of Beatitudes, Capernaum, Chorazin, Magdala, and Jordan River Baptisms. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 7 – Sunday, July 12

Mt. Gilboa, Spring of Harod, Qumran (Cave 4 and Lunch), and afternoon at the Dead Sea. Overnight at the Dead Sea.

Day 8 – Monday, July 13

Masada, En Gedi, and Wadi Qilt (Jericho Road Overlook). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9 – Tuesday, July 14

Israel Museum (model and Dead Sea Scrolls), City of David, Davidson Center (Southern Wall Excavations), Western Wall Prayer. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 11 – Wednesday, July 15

Bethlehem (Church of Nativity and Shepherd's Field), Mount of Olives, Dominus Flevit, Garden of Gethsemane, optional free time in the Old City. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 12 – Thursday, July 16

Jaffe Gate, Cardo, Gennath Gate, Whol Museum, Church of the Holy Sepulchre, and communion at a first century rolling stone tomb. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 13 – Friday, July 17

Return to the U.S.
