PROGRAM ITINERARY | March 16-March 28, 2026

Day 1 - Monday, March 16

Depart from the U.S.

Day 2 - Tuesday, March 17

Arrive in Israel. Overnight in Netanya (north of Tel Aviv on the Mediterranean coastline).

Day 3 – Wednesday, March 18

Caesarea, Mount Carmel, and Arbel Overlook and hike down. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4 - Thursday, March 19

Jordan River baptism, Katzrin, Capernaum, Magdala, Nof Ginnosar (ancient boat), and a nighttime boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5 - Friday, March 20

Har Bental (Syria overlook), Banias (Caesarea Philippi), and Dan. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 6 - Saturday, March 21

Elah Valley, Bethlehem, and Israel Museum (model, shrine of the book, and archeological wing). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 7 - Sunday, March 22

Masada, Qumran, Ein Gedi (hike to waterfalls), Dead Sea (with an option to swim), and Wadi Qilt (Jericho Road overlook). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 - Monday, March 23

City of David, Hezekiah's Tunnel (wet), Western Wall Tunnels, Prayer at Western Wall, Davidson Center (Southern Wall Excavations), and free time in the Old City. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9 - Tuesday, March 24

Mount of Olives, Dominus Flevit, Garden of Gethsemane, Jaffa Gate, Tower of David Museum, Cardo, Gennath Gate, Wohl Museum (high priestly mansions), Church of the Holy Sepulchre, and communion at a first-century tomb. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 10 - Wednesday, March 25

Depart from Israel to U.S. or continue with optional Jordan extension.

JORDAN EXTENSION:

Day 10 - Wednesday, March 25

Drive to Eliat. Wadi Rum. Overnight in Wadi Rum.

Day 11 - Thursday, March 26

Petra, Mt. Nebo. Overnight in Amman.

Day 12 - Friday, March 27

Amman Museum, Ancient Amman (Old Testament). Overnight in Amman.

Day 13 – Saturday, March 28

Depart to U.S. from Amman
