PROGRAM ITINERARY | October 5-18, 2026

Day 1 - Monday, October 5

Depart from the U.S.

Day 2 - Tuesday, October 6

Arrive in Israel. Overnight in Netanya (north of Tel Aviv on the Mediterranean coastline).

Day 3 - Wednesday, October 7

Caesarea, Mount Carmel, Nazareth, and Arbel Synagogue. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4 - Thursday, October 8

Mt. of Beatitudes, Chorizin, Capernaum, Magdala, and Jordan River Baptism. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5 - Friday, October 9

Dan, Banias (Caesarea Philippi), Har Bental (Syria overlook), and Nof Ginnosar (ancient boat), and a nighttime boat ride on the Sea of Galilee Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 6 - Saturday, October 10

Israel Museum (Model and Scrolls), Bethlehem, and Herodian. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 7 - Sunday, October 11

Masada, Qumran, Ein Gedi, Dead Sea (with an option to swim), and Wadi Qilt (Jericho Road overlook). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 - Monday, October 12

Yad Vashem (1 hour), City of David (Hezekiah's Tunnel and Pool of Silioam), Davidson Center (Southern Wall Excavations), and Western Wall. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9 - Tuesday, October 13

Mount of Olives, Dominus Flevit, Garden of Gethsemane, Jaffa Gate, Tower of David Museum, Cardo, Gennath Gate, Church of the Holy Sepulcher, and communion at a first-century tomb.

Day 10 - Wednesday, October 14

Depart from Israel. Arrive back in the U.S.

Day 10 - Wednesday, October 14

Fly to Cairo. Grand Egyptian Museum. Overnight in Cairo.

Day 11 – Thursday, October 15

Sakkara, Giza Plateau (Pyramids, Camel Rides, and Sphinx). Evening flight to Luxor. Overnight in Luxor.

Day 12 - Friday, October 16

Sunrise Hot Air Balloon Ride, Karnak Temple, and Luxor Temple. Overnight in Luxor.

Day 13 - Saturday, October 17

Valley of the Kings and Queen Hatshepsut Temple. Evening flight back to Cairo.

Day 14 - Sunday, October 18

Depart for US
