PROGRAM ITINERARY | March 9-19, 2027

Day 1 – Tuesday, March 9

Depart from the U.S.

Day 2 – Wednesday, March 10

Arrive in Israel. Overnight in Netanya (north of Tel Aviv on the Mediterranean coastline).

Day 3 – Thursday, March 11

Caesarea, Mount Carmel, and Arbel Synagogue. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4 – Friday, March 12

Nazareth (Church of Annunciation and Mt. Precipice), Kefer Kedem, and Magdala. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5 – Saturday, March 13

Almagor, Mt. of Beatitudes, Chorizin, Capernaum, and Jordan River Baptism. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 6 – Sunday, March 14

Dan, Banias (Caesarea Philippi), Har Bental (Syria overlook), ancient boat and boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 7 – Monday, March 15

Masada, Qumran, Dead Sea (with an option to swim), and Wadi Qilt (Jericho Road overlook). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 – Tuesday, March 16

Israel Museum, Bethlehem (Church and Shepherd's Field), and visit to Jerusalem School-Bethlehem. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9 – Wednesday, March 17

Temple Mount, Western Wall Tunnels, City of David, and Davidson Center (Southern Wall Excavations), and free time in the Old City. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 10 – Thursday, March 18

Mount of Olives, Dominus Flevit, Garden of Gethsemane, Jaffa Gate, Tower of David Museum, Cardo, Gennath Gate, Whol Museum, Church of the Holy Sepulchre, and communion at a first-century tomb. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 11 – Friday, March 19

Depart from Israel. Arrive back in the U.S.
