PROGRAM ITINERARY | February 15-27, 2027

Day 1 - Monday, February 15

Depart from the U.S.

Day 2 - Tuesday, February 16

Arrive in Israel. Overnight in Netanya (north of Tel Aviv on the Mediterranean coastline).

Day 3 - Wednesday, February 17

Caesarea, Mount Carmel, and Arbel Overlook and hike down. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4 - Thursday, February 18

Jordan River baptism, Katzrin, Capernaum, Magdala, Nof Ginnosar (ancient boat), and a nighttime boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 5 - Friday, February 19

Har Bental (Syria overlook), Banias (Caesarea Philippi), and Dan. Overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

Day 6 - Saturday, February 20

Elah Valley, Bethlehem, and Israel Museum (model, shrine of the book, and archeological wing). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 7 - Sunday, February 21

Masada, Qumran, Ein Gedi (hike to waterfalls), Dead Sea (with an option to swim), and Wadi Qilt (Jericho Road overlook). Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 8 - Monday, February 22

City of David, Hezekiah's Tunnel (wet), Western Wall Tunnels, Prayer at Western Wall, Davidson Center (Southern Wall Excavations), and free time in the Old City. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 9 - Tuesday, February 23

Mount of Olives, Dominus Flevit, Garden of Gethsemane, Jaffa Gate, Tower of David Museum, Cardo, Gennath Gate, Wohl Museum (high priestly mansions), Church of the Holy Sepulchre, and communion at a first-century tomb. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 10 - Wednesday, February 24

Drive from Israel to Jordan (Return to the USA for non-extension participants)

Drive to Eliat. Wadi Rum. Overnight in Wadi Rum.

Day 11 - Thursday, February 25

Petra, Mt. Nebo. Overnight in Amman.

Day 12 - Friday, February 26

Amman Museum, Ancient Amman (Old Testament). Overnight in Amman.
